American Rock Salt was given the state bid (contract) at \$68.80 a ton, but came back and said they would meet last year's price of \$64.00/ton.

Apalachee offered price of \$68.41/ton.

Problems with American over the last 2 years

- cut us off from more shipments after sold the amount in contract

- salt clumped together easily, small pieces and general quality issues

Apalachee is a better quality product with larger pieces that stay on the road longer and does not clump like American.

Coleman made a motion to use Apalachee, Schwartz seconded. All members approved.
